



Early Years Funding Policy September 2026

1. Introduction

Alleyn's Hampstead is a registered provider under the Early Education Funding for eligible 3 and 4 year olds, which entitles parents to up to 15 hours per week of free entitlement funding, up to a maximum of 495 hours each year, over a minimum of 33 weeks of the year split into three Funding Blocks. Each child can benefit from a maximum of six Funding Blocks from the start of the first Funding Block following their 3rd birthday.

Alleyn's Hampstead offers up to 15 hours of free entitlement funding; there are no plans to extend the scheme beyond 15 hours per week.

2. Eligibility

Eligibility is based on the birth date of the child as follows:

- A child born between 1st April and 31st August (inclusive) will be eligible from the start of the Autumn Funding Block from the 3rd birthday.
- A child born between 1st September and 31st December (inclusive) will be eligible from the start of the Spring Funding Block from the 3rd birthday.
- A child born between 1st January and 31st March (inclusive) will be eligible from the start of the Summer Funding Block from the 3rd birthday.

New parents must complete a Parent Contract supplied by the local authority in respect of any child for whom the Early Education Funding Entitlement is being claimed.

3. Funded and additional hours

Within each Nursery session, three hours (mornings from 8.30am to 11.30am) will be provided as Early Years Funding to those children who qualify for the Early Years Grant. The additional hours for each session in excess of the Early Years Free Entitlement will be charged at the privately funded rate for each separate session.

4. Offers

To qualify for Early Education Funding a child must attend a minimum of five morning Nursery sessions each week. Places for any session are not guaranteed, are strictly subject to availability and staffing ratios, and are granted on a 'first come, first served' basis. The school reserves the right to withdraw from this Scheme at any time.

Availability is assessed on an ongoing basis, considering any leavers or room moves. We will inform you if a place becomes available. If your child does not receive a place to start at the requested time, they will remain on the waiting list until a place becomes available or until you request for them to be removed.

5. Acceptance of a place

When you are offered an Early Education funded place, you will be given 48 hours to accept the place. If you do not accept the place within this timeframe, we will offer the place to the next family on our waiting list.

6. Invoicing and additional services

For children attending the Nursery on the 15 hours free entitlement funding basis, this will be shown as a zero cost on each invoice submitted to parents in respect of Nursery or Reception fees.

Please note the Early Education funding allocated by the council is for 33 weeks per year, a maximum of 11 weeks per term. Any additional weeks that your child attends that are not covered by the 33 weeks of funding will be considered an additional service. This will be billed each term at the advertised rate.

Additional services such as meals and snacks, consumables such as nappies and sun cream, and services such as trips, breakfast clubs, tea clubs, holiday clubs and specialist tuition, are also not included in the Early Years Free Entitlement. Optional extras and additional services booked by parents will be billed termly.

7. Meals and food

It is the policy at Alleyn's Hampstead to encourage all children to eat the food provided by the School and Nursery. This is a safeguarding measure designed to reduce the risk from hazards such as allergens (we are a 'nut free' setting), food poisoning and choking. In addition, the policy helps us combat food inequality, promote communal, healthy eating and enables us to embed mealtimes within the wider curriculum, where children learn about specific foodstuffs and then eat them. It also encourages children to use cutlery and to enjoy the whole dining experience in readiness for moving into compulsory education. Please refer to Appendix 1 for prices.

8. Notice of withdrawal

Written notice of the removal of a pupil must be received by the Head before the first day of term at the end of which it is to take effect. In the absence of the appropriate written notice, the school fee for the following term must be paid and the fee deposit will be offset against any outstanding fees due.

Early Education Funding (EYF) for eligible pupils

Alleyn's Hampstead is pleased to offer 15 hours of free entitlement funding under the Government's Early Education funding.

Three and four year olds can claim their 15 hours of free entitlement at Alleyn's Hampstead from the term after their third birthday. All hours in addition to the Early Years Free Entitlement are charged at the advertised rate and are also payable via Childcare Vouchers.

Option 1 (inclusive of 15 funded hours at £0.00)

Fees in this option are for parents wishing to book additional sessions which are inclusive of morning snacks, local school trips and events.

Option 2

The 15 hours of free entitlement is delivered free of charge for parents wishing to access the funded hours only. This option does not include school trips or events. These are considered optional additional services which are billed termly.

Meals

We offer all children a varied and exciting series of menus using quality locally sourced ingredients at an additional cost.

Lunches cost £450 a term for both Main School and Nursery (full-time pupils). To control risks associated with allergens, we do not permit packed lunches. Where pupils attend for funded hours only, these contributions are voluntary. Children staying for lunches can be collected after their lunchtime session.

Lunch is billed termly alongside the school fee invoice, with any additional sessions or services booked being billed separately.
